



5. Select provide consent:

A NSW Government website | NSW Health | NSW School Vaccination Program

This online form allows parents/guardians to provide consent for their child to be vaccinated through the NSW School Vaccination Program.

This form will take approximately 10 minutes to complete. You will need your child's Medicare card number to link their vaccination data to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), if they have one.

We encourage you to talk to your child about receiving the vaccine. If your child is 18 years or over, they can consent to receive the vaccine.

6. Complete all fields: child's school, year your child is in, child's details, parent or guardian details, home address and child's Medicare details.

NSW School Vaccination Program

For your child to be offered vaccination at school, please complete the steps below:

- enter personal details for you and your child (Step 1)
- read the Parent Information Kit (Step 2)
- make a declaration and provide consent for vaccination (Step 3)

If your child does not have a Medicare card, consent for vaccination can be still given by requesting a paper-based consent form directly from your child's school.

7. Year 7 children in Australia are scheduled to receive two vaccines:
- dTpa (Boostrix) diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis
 - HPV (Gardasil) human papilloamvirus.

If you wish to provide consent for both vaccines tick both boxes to consent to scheduled vaccines.

If you do not want your child to receive the full vaccination schedule only tick and consent for the vaccine you wish your child to receive.

8. Year 10 children in Australia are scheduled to receive a single dose of:
- MenACWY (Nimenrix) meningococcal ACWY
